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EXERCISE 4 GLOBAL LEARNING

UNIT D: ELABORATION OF RELEVANT CASE STUDIES IN BERLIN AND DEVELOPMENT OF ALLIANCES WITH KEY-STAKEHOLDERS AND EXPERTS

Building upon your theoretical knowledge acquired until today on the topic of inclusion and exclusion as well as your proposal for a significant case study in Berlin you are now asked to elaborate on the chosen area. The aim will be to present a thorough case study as well as to develop a study visit during our URBAN LAB+ symposium in March 2013.

This research will be theoretically as well as empirically:

1. THEORETICAL BACKGROUND

Summarize key-facts on your case study regarding the following aspects:

- a) Geographical situation
- b) Urban and architectural project description (esp. spatial, functional)
- c) Historical overview (origin, development, current status)
- d) Essential framework (e.g. social, political, financial, with focus on today's situation as well as relevant times of the past; make sure to thoroughly research on the aspect of inclusion and/or exclusion)
- e) Key-stakeholders (during the development phase as well as today)

Make sure to mention all your sources used for your research.

2. EMPIRICAL RESEARCH IN-SITU

Go in-situ and expand your research focussing on spatial, functional and social aspects as well as relevant stakeholders in the respective case study or related to its development.

3. APPOINTING OF KEY-STAKEHOLDERS AND NOMINATION OF INTERVIEW PARTNER(S)

According to your main findings, appoint possible key-stakeholders and experts as interview partners. Develop a first draft of an interview questionnaire.

4. ELABORATION OF A COMMON CASE STUDY VISIT DURING THE URBAN LAB+ SYMPOSIUM

Work up a possible study visit on one or several crucial areas of your case study, including ideas on the information of the visitors, possible meetings of stakeholders or experts, means of transportation, and time frame.
